NOTIFICATION

The 14th November, 2014

No. G.S.R. 62/Const./Art. 309/2014.-In exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules regulating the recruitment and conditions of Service of the persons appointed to the Punjab Animal Husbandry (Group-A) Service, namely:-

RULES

1. **Short title commencement and application.**-(1) These rules may be called the Punjab Animal Husbandry (Group-A) Service Rules, 2014.
  - (2) They shall come into force on and with effect from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
  - (3) They shall apply to the posts specified in Appendix 'A'.
2. **Definitions.**-in these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
  - (a) "Appendix" means the appendix, appended to these rules;
  - (b) "Government" means the Government of the State of Punjab in the Department of Animal Husbandry, Fisheries and Dairy Development, Punjab;
  - (c) "Commission" means the Punjab Public Service Commission, Patiala; and
  - (d) "Service" means the Punjab Animal Husbandry (Group-A) Service.
3. **Number and character of Posts.**-The service shall comprise the posts specified in Appendix 'A':

Provided that nothing in these rules shall effect the inherent right of the Government to add to or reduce the number of such posts or to create new posts with different designations and scales of pay whether permanently or temporarily.

4. **Appointing authority.**-Appointments to the Service shall be made by the Government.

5. **Method of appointment qualifications and experience.**-(1) Appointment to the Service shall be made in the manner as specified in Appendix 'B'.

Provided that if, no suitable candidate is available for appointment by promotion or by direct appointment, then, appointment to the Service shall be made by transfer from the persons holding a similar or an identical post under a State Government or Government of India.

- (2) No person shall be appointed to the Service, unless he possesses the qualifications and experience, as specified against the post in Appendix 'B'.

- (3) Appointment to the Service by promotion shall be made on seniority-cum-merit basis, but no person shall have any right to claim promotion on the basis of seniority alone.

6. **Pay of members of the Service.**-The members of the Service shall be entitled to such scales of pay, as may be authorized by the Government from time to time. The scales of pay, at present in force, in respect of the members of the Service, are given in Appendix 'A'.

7. **Discipline, punishment and appeal.**-(1) In the matters of discipline, punishment and appeal, the members of the Service shall be governed by the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1970, as amended from time to time.

- (2) The authority empowered to impose penalties, as specified in rule 5 of the Punjab Civil Service (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1970 in respect of the members of the Service, shall be the Government.

8. **Applications of the Punjab Civil Service (General and Common Conditions of Service) Rules, 1994.**-(1) In respect of the matters, which are not specifically provided in these rules, the members of the Service shall be governed by the Punjab Civil Services (General and Common Conditions of Service) Rules, 1994, as amended from time to time.

- (2) The Punjab Civil Services (General and Common Conditions of Service) Rules, 1994, at present in force, are contained in Appendix 'C'.

9. **Repeal and saving.**-The Punjab Animal Husbandry (Class-1) Service Rules, 1996, in so far as they are applicable to the members of the Service are hereby repealed:

Provided that any order issued or any action taken under the rules so repealed, shall be deemed to have been issued or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

10. **Interpretation.**-If any question arises as to the interpretation of these rules, the Government in consultation with Department of personnel shall decide the same.
